

CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

A special meeting of the Beach City Council was called to order by Mayor Walter Losinski at 8:30 am on September 30, 2013. Present when the meeting was called to order was City Council Henry Gerving, Tim Marman, Mark Benes, Wade Walworth and City Auditor Kimberly Nunberg.

The purpose for the special meeting was to accept the resignation of Public Works Employee Austin Fulton. Gerving moved to accept the resignation effective October 8, second by Walworth. Motion carried unanimously. The City is currently advertising for a Public Works Supervisor and has a closing application date of October 11th. Marman suggested Fulton work directly with employees Mike Braden and Bart Bishop this week. Gerving recommended Fulton prepare a written standard operating procedure (SOP) for equipment, checking wells, etc. to be used by future employees.

No other business was brought forward. Gerving moved to adjourn, second by Walworth. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 9:00 a.m.
