

BEACH ZONING BOARD PROCEEDINGS

Nunberg informed the Zoning Board a Petition for Annexation was presented to the City Council on September 4th. The annexation would be for approximately 300 acres north of I-94. The public hearing on the annexation will be held October 1st at 7:30 pm. Nunberg mentioned the Beach Trap Club & Pheasants Forever submitted an Application for Building. The original building has been removed; a new building will be moved in and placed on a cement pad. Nunberg mentioned Zoning does conditionally allow contained sports facilities in a Residential 1 area. Discussion. Marman moved to conditionally approve the Application for Building submitted by the Beach Trap Club, second by Harchenko. Motion carried unanimously. All other building permits issued since the last meeting were reviewed. Marman moved to approve the building permits, second by Harchenko. Motion carried unanimously. Marman requested Nunberg follow up on Paul Popiel's breezeway that is being constructed.

Wanner moved to adjourn, second by Harchenko. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 8:30 a.m.
