

CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
PUBLISHED SUBJECT TO THE GOVERNING BODY'S REVIEW AND REVISION

A regular meeting of the Beach City Council was called to order by Mayor Losinski at 7:00 pm July 19, 2010. Present when the meeting was called to order was Council Jeanne Larson, Tim Marman, Wade Walworth, Mark Benes, Mike Bingeman, Paul Lautenschlager, Deputy Sheriff John Moll, PWS Dell Beach, PW Kent Shaw and City Auditor Kimberly Nunberg.

The Sheriff's Report consisting of 18 calls during the month of June was reviewed. Mayor Losinski requested Deputy Moll issue citation on a vehicle blocking an alley.

Beach reported on street repairs that have been completed. There are approximately 18 blocks remaining to be chip sealed along with the high school parking lot. An inspection report from Midco Diving and Marine Services was reviewed. Beach will obtain a price for repairs which need to be made on the South water tower. There was discussion of semi trucks using 2nd Ave NE. Nunberg was requested to send notice to the individuals using 2nd Ave NE explaining it is not a Truck Route and will not be allowed.

An Application for Raffle submitted by Spirit of the West was reviewed. Benes moved to approve the raffle application, second by Bingeman. Motion carried unanimously. An application for a Special Events from the Backyard was reviewed. Discussion. Marman moved to approve the special event for Saturday night only contingent upon security being provided, if no security is provided no future permits will be granted, second by Walworth. Motion carried unanimously. Correspondence was read from ND Land Department regarding two grants received.

No other business was brought forward. Walworth moved to adjourn, second by Larson. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 7:40 pm.
