

CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
PUBLISHED SUBJECT TO THE GOVERNING BODY'S REVIEW AND REVISION

A regular meeting of the Beach City Council was called to order by Mayor Losinski at 7:00 pm on November 16, 2009. Present when the meeting was called to order was Council Perry Stockwell, Jeanne Larson, Tim Marman, Wade Walworth, Public Works Kent Shaw, City Auditor Kimberly Nunberg and guest Alysia Steele.

Public Works Shaw reported on tree trimming and a sewer backup that occurred today. Nunberg reviewed Renaissance Zone Projects 16-Bea and 17-Bea. Walworth moved to approve both Renaissance Zone projects, second by Larson. Motion carried unanimously. Correspondence from the Community Ambulance Service regarding installation of more street signs was read. Correspondence from Prairie West Development regarding participation in a Labor Study was discussed. Marman moved to participant in the Labor Study, second by Larson. Motion carried unanimously. Nunberg reviewed balances in the Garbage Fund Budget. Marman moved to amend the Garbage Repair Budget from \$7000 to \$18000 due to digging a new pit at the landfill, second by Walworth. Motion carried unanimously.

Alysia Steele expressed concerns on the sidewalk North of the Pharmacy. The Street Committee will address the issue. Alysia also requested a handicap sign be placed on the on North side of the Pharmacy. Public Works will handle the request.

No other business was brought forward. Marman moved to adjourn, second by Larson. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 7:30 pm.
