Public Works Report

PWS Dietz written report was reviewed. Zachmann moved to approve the request of \$150 in Beach Bucs to be given to Dell Beach for his assistance with the oil distributor, second by Larson. Motion carried unanimously.

Auditor Report

Gaugler reviewed her written report. Gaugler reviewed the semi-annual Revenue and Expenditures Budget reports. A preliminary budget for 2021 will be reviewed at the next meeting. A request was made for the City to sponsor a social distance lunch in Gazebo Park on

August 1st. Marman moved due to COVID-19 pandemic the City would not be able to sponsor the lunch, second by Zachmann. Motion carried unanimously.

Engineers Report

Engineer Klein review his written report. Three alternative plans for the 2021 Street and Utility Project were presented. Klein explained the alternative plans were developed based on public input gathered at the informational meeting held on June 15th. See attachments maps/estimates.

Committee Reports

Street Committee – Mayor Gerving complimented the PW Dept. on the 6 blocks of chip sealing recently completed.

Police Committee – Mayor Gerving mentioned concerns of Chinese Lanterns that were lit and released on July 4th.

Unfinished Business

Request by Prairie West Development Foundation – Marman moved to provide \$6,250 from the City Sales Tax Community Enhancement Fund to Prairie West Development Foundation for operational expenses, second by Wolff. Motion carried unanimously.

New Business

Correspondence was read from Southwestern District Health Unit regarding the recently passed Federal Law Tobacco 21.

Correspondence was read from Southwest Water Authority regarding the Annual Water Quality Report.

Correspondence was read from ND DOT regarding the Transportation Alternatives Funding in the amount of up to \$200,000 that has been awarded for 3rd Street SW Multi-Use Trail Expansion Project. This project would be completed by the end of the 2022 construction season. Marman moved to notify ND DOT the local match needed for this project will be available, second by Larson. Roll call vote was taken. Marman-yes, Wolff-yes, Larson-yes, Puckett-yes, Zachmann-yes, Hegel-yes. – Motion carried unanimously.

An Application for Special Events on August 2, 2020 submitted by The Legion, Inc. was reviewed. A decision was tabled. Gaugler will confirm the date/time before the next meeting.

Quit Claim Deeds between the City of Beach and Eugene Padilla were reviewed. Zachmann moved to approve, second by Wolff. Motion carried unanimously.

Swanson-Puckett request there be further discussion or reconsideration on committee assignments made at the June 23 Re-Organizational Meeting.

No other business was brought forward. Wolff moved to adjourn, second by Marman. Meeting adjourned at 8:20 p.m.
