

CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
PUBLISHED SUBJECT TO THE GOVERNING BODY'S REVIEW AND REVISION

A special meeting of the Beach City Council was called to order by Mayor Jeanne Larson on October 12, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. Present when the meeting was called to order was City Council Nick Hegel, Lynn Swanson-Puckett, Sarah Ross, Bev Wolff, Andy Zachmann, City Auditor Kimberly Gaugler and guests Lea Farstveet, Loni Thilmony and Dima Davydenko.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll call was taken. Tim Marman was absent.

The purpose of the special meeting was to hold a Public Hearing for comment on the confirmed Special Assessments for Water Improvement District No. 2021-1. Swanson-Puckett moved to open the Public Hearing, second by Ross. Motion carried unanimously. Chairperson of the Special Assessment Committee Lea Farstveet provided information on the process used to determine the special assessments for each benefitting property. Gaugler stated seven property owners contacted her regarding payoff amounts, length of time special assessments are in place and that no written protests were received prior to the meeting. Swanson-Puckett moved to close the Public Hearing, second by Wolff. Motion carried unanimously. Swanson-Puckett moved to approve the confirmed Special Assessments for the Water Improvement District 2021-1, second by Wolff. Motion carried unanimously.

Hegel moved to adjourn, second by Zachmann. Meeting adjourned at 6:15 p.m.
