

CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
PUBLISHED SUBJECT TO THE GOVERNING BODY'S REVIEW AND REVISION

A special meeting of the Beach City Council was called to order by Mayor Walter Losinski on May 13, 2024 at 1:00 p.m. for the purpose of reviewing information and considering purchase of a 2001 sewer jetter truck. Present when the meeting was called to order was City Council Nick Hegel (via telephone), Tom Marman, Lynn Swanson-Puckett (via telephone), Sarah Ross (via telephone), Bev Wolff, Andy Zachmann, Public Works Superintendent Randy Dietz, City Auditor Kimberly Gaugler, and guest Gary Howard.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll call was taken. All members were present.

PWS Dietz reviewed information he recently received from RDO Equipment regarding a sewer jetter truck for sale. Price of the sewer jetter truck is \$75,000. Ross inquired where the sewer jetter truck would be stored and what funds could be used to purchase the equipment. City Auditor Gaugler provide information on the budget as well as what funds could be used for purchase of the sewer jetter truck.

Marman moved that he and PWS Dietz travel to Minot to inspect the sewer jetter truck and be granted discretion on purchase of the truck, second by Wolff. Motion carried unanimously.

Wolff moved to adjourn the special meeting, second by Zachmann. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 1:24 p.m.
