

CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
PUBLISHED SUBJECT TO THE GOVERNING BODY'S REVIEW AND REVISION

The reorganizational meeting of the Beach City Council was called to order by Mayor Walter Losinski on June 28, 2016 at 7:00 pm. Present when the meeting was called to order was City Council Dell Beach, Tim Marman, Mark Benes, Jeanne Larson, Wade Walworth, City Auditor Kimberly Nunberg, Engineer Kenzie Robertson and Loren Hoffman, guests Father Dan Berg and Robert Schmeling.

Canvassing Results of the Primary Election are as follows; Publication of Minutes: Yes – 224, No – 14. City Council: Mark Benes - 159 Wade Walworth – 144 Jeanne Larson – 121 Robert Schmeling – 121 Theresa Medina 103 Park Board: Jennifer Erickson – 206 Rachel Keohane 205 Mike Braden – 197.

Marman moved to approve flipping a coin to determine the tie between Larson and Schmeling, second by Walworth. Beach – yes, Marman – yes, Larson – yes, Walworth – yes, Benes – no. Motion carried. Father Dan Berg flipped a coin that had Larson's name on one side and Schmeling's name on the other. Coin flip determined Larson would continue serving on the City Council. Mayor Losinski thanked both candidates for their willingness to serve the City.

Mayor Losinski called for nominations of President and Vice President of the City Council. Walworth moved to elect Mark Benes as President of the City Council, second by Larson. Motion carried unanimously. Marman moved to elect Wade Walworth as Vice President of the City Council, second by Larson. Motion carried unanimously.
