A regular meeting of the Beach City Council was called to order by Mayor Walter Losinski on July 21, 2014 at 7:00 pm. Present when the meeting was called to order was City Council Tim Marman, Mark Benes, Jeanne Larson, City Auditor Kimberly Nunberg, guests Jim Schulte and Renea Smith.

Committee Report:

Zoning – Larson reported on the Zoning Board Public Hearing held on July 17th at 7 pm. The Zoning Board tabled a decision on the request by Beach Co-op Grain for re-zoning until their next regular meeting on August 18th.

New Business:

There was a Public Hearing on a recommendation given by the Zoning Board to change the NE ¼ Section 14, Township 140, Range 106 from Agriculture to Industrial. No public comment was given. Larson moved to approve the recommendation by the Zoning Board, second by Marman. Motion carried unanimously. An Application for Special Events submitted by La Playa Restaurant was reviewed. Benes moved to approve the Special Events, second by Larson. Motion carried unanimously. An Application for Raffle from Golden Valley County Women in Ag was reviewed. Benes moved to approve the raffle, second by Larson. Motion carried unanimously. An Application for Property Tax Exemption at 931 4th Ave NW was reviewed. Marman moved to approve the property tax exemption, second by Larson. Motion carried unanimously. An Application for Special Events submitted by Interstate Cenex was reviewed. Nunberg mentioned until Interstate Cenex obtains a State License they would not be eligible to apply for a Special Events License. Discussion. Marman moved to approve the Special Events License contingent on Interstate Cenex receiving their State License, second by Benes. Motion carried unanimously. Schulte requested the name on their Beer License be changed to Farmers Union Oil Company of Beach. Larson moved to correct the name on their Beer License as is requested, second by Marman. Motion carried unanimously.
